Kyla Mazzotta

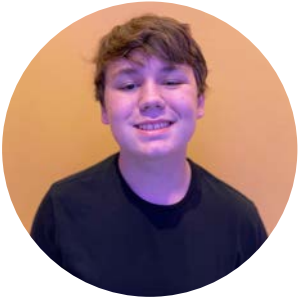

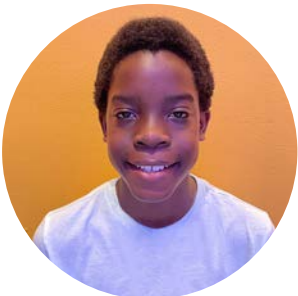
Hannah Moribe
