# **DIRECTOR'S NOTES**

Like many of you here, I have experienced the whirlwind of unpredictable changes to childcare, and life as a whole, over the past year. As a mother of two small children, I was thrust into teaching fulltime on Zoom, while navigating the loss of childcare for my two-year-old and meeting the homeschooling needs of my seven-year-old. At times, I found myself stretched so thin that I did not even know where my toddler was – was he making bubbles in the bathroom sink? Was he running around diaperless? As long as no one was injured, I considered it a moderate success in the world of pandemic parenting.

Together, in the quiet of the early morning, we were blessed with a beautiful sunrise, scenic views, and the playful togetherness for which I had so been longing.

It is my wish that *The Teddy Bears' Picnic* will offer a similar solace to you: Mama Bear, Papa Bear, Grandma, Grandpa, Sitter, or Caregiver. May you find peace resting under the canopy of our picnic tree, watching your child participate in the magic of theatre, and playing along. The time we spend with children can be exhausting yet joyful, simple yet magical, full of routine yet full of surprises. May we hold all of these things together as we share this time together, celebrating the return of live theatre and the powerful connection it brings. And, if you find yourselves wanting to keep the story alive, pay a visit to the "The Mayor at Loch Haven Park" – the tree which served as the inspiration for our picnic spot for a picnic of your own! These moments to carve out meaningful time with our little ones are invaluable, and I hope today offers you that opportunity.
