A Message From The Director

Welcome to *Pete The Cat!* I hope you are ready to jam, as that is Pete's favorite thing to do. We had just started this show at the end of February 2020 and stopped on March 13 for what we thought was going to be two weeks. We are thankful to be back two years later and that you are here! Chances are if you are here, you know this cool cat already as he is featured in over 60 books and countless games and toys and a television show, which is super impressive since he was only introduced in 2008!

We are having a such a fun time working on this show and I want to use this space to share with you the team effort that is involved in bringing this show to you. It begins on the page with the Artistic Director reading the script and working with the Company Manager to secure the rights. This is the most favorite part of my job and the most stressful- selecting stories that you want to see on stage and that serve all the functions of a show that we need it to serve. Then, I get to work as the Director of the show and work with a team of incredible designers to come up with the world of the play- what it looks like, what magic can be created. This is the most fun part where all the dreaming begins. Then, our administrative team gets involved with the Executive Director, the Development office, and the Board of Directors working on securing funding to keep moving the production forward. The Marketing team starts creating artwork and marketing strategies. Our Education Department begins creating Resource Guides and securing children's artwork related to the show for the lobby and have created classes around the show.

The Production Department gets to work by building the sets and costumes and props and getting the lighting and sound equipment ready, all while making sure we are on budget and on time. We gather the actors and then get to the rehearsal process. This is where the fun really amps up as the Assistant Director, Choreographer, Music Director, and Stage Management team and technical crew join the process and even more magic is created. When we are finally ready, the Front of House team is who you experience at the theatre first. They have prepared the lobbies and concessions and show merchandise and pre-show activities for you. The Box Office team and the Group Sales team work to make your visit smooth and enjoyable. Incredible volunteers join to serve as ushers and ticket-takers.

Then, the most important members of the team join the process- you! And the person behind you, beside you, and in front of you. All of us have worked together to create this play, a moment in time- a moment that allows us to imagine together and, in this case, laugh and smile together. All of us together create a community- the magic of theatre has brought us together. Each performance is special because each performance exists in a time and space for just that group gathered that specific day in that time and place. We share this art together and Pete The Cat would say that is mighty groovy.


