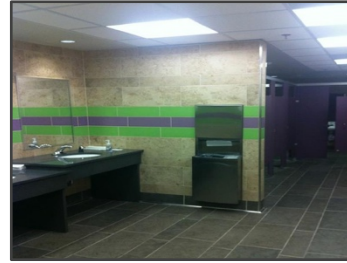
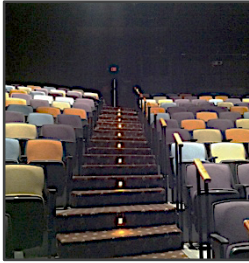
It will be louder if I sit closer to the stage. It will be quieter if I sit further away from the stage.
