## Taryn Rozefort

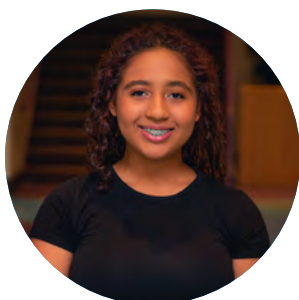

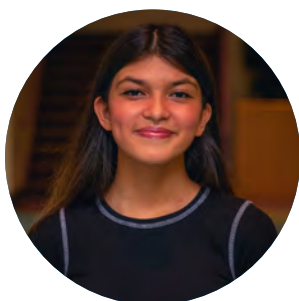
### Natalia Still

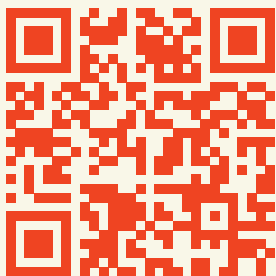
